BAPTISM REQUIREMENTS

1. Parents, planning to have their children baptized at St. Paschal Baylon Church, must live within the boundaries of our Parish and be registered. If not registered, they will be invited to do so and attend Mass for 6 months, before meeting with one of the Parish priests.
2. Parents not married in the Roman Catholic Church will be allowed to celebrate only the baptism of their first child. No other child will be baptized unless the parents decide to validate their wedding in the Roman Catholic Church.
3. At least one of the parents must be Roman Catholic and provide a baptism certificate to prove it.
